

## Kickstart your coffee experience in Copenhagen

**Iced coffee, coffee cocktails, soft-serve coffee ice cream, and coffee brownies, and of course, all the classic coffee menus. The coffee guide *CoffeeCopenhagen* is brimming with coffee experiences at vastly different coffee spots—from Scandinavian minimalist to those full of colorful whimsical knickknacks. The book is divided into Copenhagen's city districts to help the reader easily find their way.**



For the past 25 years, there have been coffee shops and to-go-coffee in Copenhagen. But as of yet there has not been a guide to help you taste your way through the Nordic capital. In ***CoffeeCopenhagen—55 creative coffee spots and 1 mocha moped***, barista Anja Olsen takes the reader on a journey through six neighborhoods and the very special coffee experiences that Copenhagen offers.

- Several English-speaking local Copenhageners and tourists have bought the Danish version of the coffee guide and just followed the addresses to find the best coffee spots, but of course it does not give the same experience as being able to read the whole book. That's why we've had the book translated into English, so now everyone can go on a coffee discovery in Copenhagen, says Anja Olsen, who owned a coffee bar in Frederiksberg for years, making her one of the fledging group of pioneers within the coffee shop concept of the 2000s.

***CoffeeCopenhagen*** offers not only concrete descriptions of selected coffee spots, it also serves the reader portraits of the greatest coffee aficionados on the Danish coffee scene—Ricco Sørensen from Riccos, Klaus Thomsen from Coffee Collective, Jonas Gehl from Prolog Coffee Bar, Esben Piper from La Cabra, who recently opened coffee bars in Bangkok and New York, and Sine Klejs Gren from Holy Bean, one of Denmark's only two female roasters.

Last but not least, the reader gains an insight into what, for instance, a cortado and Americano are, and what characterizes light-roasted and dark-roasted coffee, so that the coffee menu is easier to explore.



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
